## Overview

Thank you for your interest in joining the Resource Opportunities Centre (ROC) board of directors.

The ROC is a non-profit, community development organization serving the communities along Route 333, from Goodwood to West Dover. It is also the volunteer management board for the Prospect Road Community Centre (PRCC), which opened in 2010.

Started in 1998, the ROC's **vision** today is to encourage and promote a welcoming, innovative, and thriving community. Its mission is to be an organization dedicated to sustainability and community development through the delivery of diverse recreational, educational, cultural, social, and technology-related opportunities.

We are looking to create a board with a diversity of expertise that represents the diversity of the Prospect communities.

Currently the board meets monthly on the last Thursday of every month. The meeting schedule is determined and approved by the board annually, based on the availability of board members. Board meetings are scheduled for approximately two hours, from 6 p.m.- 8 pm. Board members are also asked to participate on at least one board committee. Currently the ROC has four formal committees, Human Resources, Finance, Governance/Operations and Communications. Directors are asked to commit between four to eight hours a month to support board and PRCC initiatives, though time may vary depending on annual activities such as the AGM, or special projects.

The board can include up to 15 directors. Currently the board has 9 members. Directors have three-year terms. New board of directors will be approved by members of the Prospect communities at the AGM.
